The Remembering Cyclone Tracy Committee Inc. was established in January 2023 to contribute to planning activities commemorating the 50th anniversary of Cyclone Tracy.

It is our aim to ensure the voices and wishes of the survivor community are heard and respected in any commemorative events.

The committee presently consists of 11 members, 9 being Cyclone Tracy survivors, and is informed by the wishes of almost 5000 members of the Cyclone Tracy Survivors Facebook page and a network which stretches across the globe.
